# 2. How to Install

**Important!** DO NOT connect the Wireless USB Adapter to your computer until instructed to do so.

1. Insert the Utility & Driver CD-ROM into your computer's CD-ROM Drive and then click Install Utility.





2. Follow the InstallShield Wizard instructions and then click Finish.



 $\underline{\text{Note:}}$  The TEW-444UB is hot-pluggable, you can connect or disconnect the TEW-444UB while the computer is on.



<u>Note</u>: Windows 2003 Server/XP/2000/ME/98SE will automatically detect and install the appropriate drivers. Skip to **section 3** for Windows 2003 Server/ XP/2000/ME. For Windows 98SE, please insert your Windows 98SE CD-ROM and continue on to **step 4**.

## 3. Wireless Configuration

<u>Note:</u> Wireless configuration requires a 802.11g or 802.11b Access Point (for Infrastructure Mode) or another 802.11g wireless adapter (for Ad-Hoc/Peer-to-Peer networking mode).

# Q1: I inserted the Utility & Driver CD-ROM into my computer's CD-ROM Drive and the installation menu does not appear automatically. What should I do?

A1: If the installation menu does not appear automatically, click Start, click Run, and type D:\setup.exe where "D" in "D:\setup.exe" is the letter assigned to your computer's CD-ROM Drive. And then click OK to start the installation.

#### Q2: When I open up the utility, all the buttons are greyed out.

A2: Verify that the device is installed properly. Right click on My Computer -> Properties. Click on Hardware, then Device Manager. Double click on Network Adapters. Make sure that 802.11g Wireless Network Adapter is listed and there is no yellow question mark or exclamation point. Also perform a reboot on the computer.

#### Q3: When I click on Scan, I can not see my SSID.

A3: Log on to your wireless router or access point and make sure that the SSID broadcast option is not disabled. Make sure the wireless light on your wireless router or access point is on.

# Q4: I completed all the steps in the Quick Installation Guide, but my Wireless USB Adapter isn't connecting to my access point. What should I do?

A4: First, verify that the Network Name (SSID) matches your wireless router or wireless access point's SSID. Second, check your TCP/IP properties to ensure that Obtain an IP address automatically is selected. Third, click **Profile Management -> Scan** in the Wireless Client Utility to check and see if there are any available wireless networks listed. Third, click **Profile Management -> Scan** in the Wireless Client Utility to check and see if there are any available wireless networks listed.

#### Q5: The utility program shows good signal strength, but I can not get onto the Internet.

A5: First, log on to your wireless router or access point and check to see if encryption is enable. If encryption is enabled, go to Profile Management -> Modify -> Security. Select the proper Security Options, click on configure, then put in the proper encryption key. Then click Ok. Second, make sure to disable any firewall programs. Third, make sure that your router is properly configured for Internet.
