Системные требования

- Компьютер с соответствующим образом установленным сетевым адаптером
- Сетевой кабель RJ-45
- Поверхность под коммутатором должна выдерживать нагрузку минимум в 1,5 кг
- Сетевая розетка должна располагаться в пределах 1,82 м (6 футов) от коммутатора
- Убедитесь в беспрепятственности отвода тепла от коммутатора и адекватности вентиляции его корпуса
- Не устанавливайте на коммутатор тяжелые предметы
- Устройство с питанием от IEEE 802.3af
- TPE-112S (дополнение)
- 19" стойка стандарта ЕІА(дополнение)

<u>Примечание</u>: устройство TPE-S80 поддерживает только устройства, питаемые по стандарту IEEE 802.3af


Оранжевый: Связь РоЕ-устройством. Не горит: Нет подключенных РоЕ-устройств

4. Присоедините кабель RJ-45 от порта РоЕ на устройстве TPE-S80 к порту LAN на стройстве РоЕ (напр., TEW-638PAP)



5. Убедитесь в загорании следующих индикаторов на панели: **Power, PoE** и **Link/ACT**.

Применение с моделями TPE-S80 и TPE-112GS устройства, не поддерживающего режим РоЕ

<u>Примечание</u>: Уточните выходное напряжение устройства, не поддерживающего режим PoE. Устройство TPE-112GS поддерживает только устройства, которые не работают в режиме PoE и имеют напряжение на выходе 5 В, 7,5 В, 9 В или 12 В.

1. Выберите нужное напряжение (5В, 7.5В, 9V или 12В).



- Присоедините кабель Ethernet от порта РоЕ на коммутаторе TPE-S80 к порту РоЕ IN на устройстве TPE-112GS.
- Подключите встроенный кабель Ethernet устройства TPE-112GS к порту LAN (ЛС) устройства, не поддерживающего PoE (напр., TEW-639GR).




- Присоедините кабельную перемычку из комплекта к устройству, не поддерживающему режим PoE (напр., TEW-639GR) и устройству TPE-112GS.
- Убедитесь в загорании следующих индикаторов на панели: Power, PoE и Link/ACT.




Установка в стойке

Коммутатор может быть установлен в 19-дюймовой стойке EIA стандартного размера, которая располагается в электромонтажном шкафу вместе с другой аппаратурой.

 Приложите крепежные скобы к обе-им сторонам коммутатора и прикрепите их имеющи-мися винтами.



2. Аккуратно расположите коммутатор на стойке. Выровняйте кронштейн тносительно винтовых отверстий на стойке, затем прикрепите коммутатор винтами из комплекта к приборной стойке.

Troubleshooting

1. After connecting the Switch to a power outlet, the LEDs do not turn on.

- 1. Check the connection of the power cord to the TPE-S80 and the power outlet.
- 2. Verify that the power switch is set to the On position.
- 3. Check that the power outlet is receiving power.

2. After I connect my PCs to the Switch, I am unable to share files.

- 1. Check the LEDs on the Switch. Make sure the Link/ACT LED is on.
- Check the network cable. The minimum length of the cable is 1.5 meters and the maximum length of the cable is 100 meters.
- 3. Disable any software firewall program.
- 4. Verify that you have file sharing enabled. Please contact your Operating System support for more information.

3. After I connect my PCs to the Switch, I can only get onto the Internet from one computer.

The Switch was not designed to share Internet between multiple computers. You need to get an Internet router such as the TW100-S4W1CA.

4. My 802.3af Powered Device does not power on when I plug the device into the Switch. What should I do?

- 1. Verify that the PoE device supports IEEE 802.3af protocol.
- 2. Verify that the power switch is set to the on position.
- 3. Power cycle the PoE switch. Unplug power to the Switch, wait 15 seconds, then plug the power back in.
- 4. Plug the device into a different port on the PoE switch.
- 5. Try using another RJ-45 network cable.

5. Where is the uplink port located on the Switch?

Since all the ports on the Switch are Auto-MDIX, any of the ports can be used as an uplink port.
