
Mirror View (Image repeated over multiple monitors)

2. How to Install

Note: Do not connect the TU2-DVIV to your computer until instructed to do so.



- **6.** Remove the Drive CD-ROM from your computer's CD-ROM drive.
- 7. Connect the Mini-USB end of the USB cable to the TU2-DVIV.




8. Connect the Type A end of the USB cable to an available USB port on your computer.



9. Repeat steps 7-8 for each additional adapter. Maximum of 6 adapters can be connected.


Connecting to a DVI monitor

 Connect the DVI monitor cable directly to the DVI port on the TU2-DVIV.



Connecting to a VGA monitor

1. Connect the VGA monitor cable to the VGA to DVI adapter.



2. Connect the VGA to DVI adapter to the TU2-DVIV.

Configure Display Settings

1. Right click on the utility icon.



2. Select the desired setting to change.

Q1: Can I connect or disconnect TU2-DVIV while the computer is on?

A1: Yes, you can connect or disconnect TU2-DVIV while the computer is on because the USB interface is Plug-and-Play compliant and hot-pluggable.

Q2: Windows is unable to recognize my hardware. What should I do?

A2: First, make sure your computer meets the minimum requirements as specified in Section 1 of this Quick Installation Guide. Second, try plugging the adapter into a different USB port.
