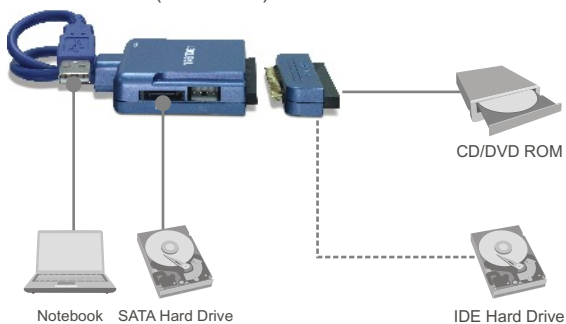

### USB 2.0 to SATA/IDE Converter Adapter (TU2-IDSA)

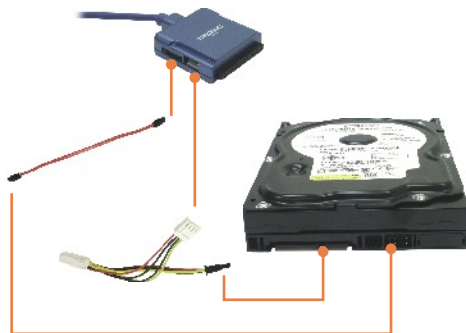


## 2. Procéder à l'installation

**Remarque:** Nous vous recommandons de formater tout d'abord un tout nouveau disque dur. Veuillez consulter la question 2 de la partie dépannage pour plus d'informations.

### Connexion du lecteur SATA

1. Branchez le câble SATA fourni à la prise SATA de votre disque dur SATA et à l'adaptateur.
2. A l'aide du câble d'alimentation HDD fourni, branchez l'extrémité à 4 mini broches à la prise DC de l'adaptateur et la fiche femelle SATA à 15 broches à la prise adéquate du disque dur. Poursuivez ensuite par l'étape 5.

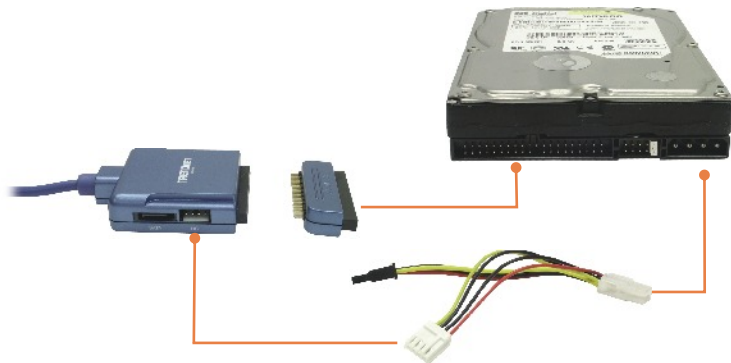


**Remarque:** Si votre disque dur SATA est équipé d'une prise d'alimentation à 4 broches, utilisez plutôt la fiche à 4 broches. Pour se brancher à la fois au disque dur IDE et au disque dur SATA avec une prise d'alimentation à 4 broches, vous avez besoin d'un câble d'alimentation à 4 broches, de type Y pour transformer une prise d'alimentation simple à 4 broches en une prise d'alimentation double à 4 broches.

## Connexion du lecteur IDE

3. Branchez votre périphérique IDE à la fiche IDE de l'adaptateur. Pour vous brancher sur un disque dur IDE 3.5" ou à un lecteur de CD/DVD 5.25", branchez d'abord le convertisseur IDE 2.5" sur le 3.5".

4. Si un périphérique IDE 3.5" ou 5.25" est branché, à l'aide du câble d'alimentation fourni, branchez l'extrémité à 4 mini broches à la prise DC de l'adaptateur et la prise femelle à 4 grandes broches à la prise d'alimentation du lecteur IDE.



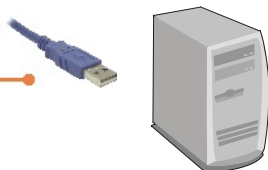
5. Branchez la fiche simple de sortie DC de l'adaptateur secteur à la fiche IN DC de l'adaptateur. Ensuite branchez le cordon d'alimentation fourni à l'adaptateur secteur et l'autre extrémité à une prise de courant AC.



Remarque : Le disque dur branché au TU2-IDSA doit être formaté en FAT-16 ou FAT-32 afin que Windows 98SE ou Windows ME le reconnaissent

Remarque: Les utilisateurs Windows 98SE sont invités à consulter la question 1 de la partie dépannage. Les utilisateurs Windows XP/2000/ME peuvent poursuivre avec l'étape 6.

6. Branchez la prise USB sur un port USB disponible de l'ordinateur. Les pilotes s'installeront automatiquement.



7. Double-cliquez sur l'icône **My Computer** (Poste de travail).



8. Le(s) disque(s) dur(s) externe(s) devrai(en)t s'afficher. Si votre disque dur est tout neuf, veuillez consulter la question 3 de la partie dépannage.



## Q1: How do I install the TU2-IDSA on my Windows 98SE machine?

**A1:** First, download the Windows 98SE drivers from [www.trendnet.com](http://www.trendnet.com). Second, uncompress the drivers. If you do not have a compression program such as WinZip, you need to download and install this program first. Third, **double-click** on the **Setup** icon. Click **OK** when the Setup successful! Window appears. Fourth, continue on to step 6 in Section 2.

## Q2: My computer does not recognize the TU2-IDSA. What should I do?

**A2:** First, verify that the computer meets the minimum requirements as listed in section 1. Second, make sure that you have plugged in the power into the unit and the power cord into an outlet. Third, try plugging the device into a different USB slot on your computer.

## Q3: How do I format my brand new hard drive?

**A3:** For Windows 2000/XP, go to **Start -> Settings -> Control Panel -> Administrative Tools -> Computer Management -> Disk Management**. If the **Initialize and Convert Disk Wizard** appears, click **Cancel**. Right click the **Unknown** drive, click **Initialize** and then click **OK**. Right click on the unallocated region of the hard drive and select **New Partition**. Follow the **New Partition Wizard** instructions then click **Finish**. The hard drive will automatically start the formatting process. For Windows 98SE/ME, right click on **My Computer**, and then click **Device Manager**. Double-click on **Disk drives**, and then double-click on your hard drive. When the hard drive properties window appears, click on the **Settings** tab. Check **Removable** in the **options** section, select an available drive letter for **Start drive letter** and then click **OK**. Click **Close**. Click **Yes** to restart the computer. Double click on **My Computer**, double-click on the hard drive and click **Yes** to format it.

## Q4: My computer does not recognize my hard drive(s)? What should I do?

**A4:** First, verify that the device is installed properly. Right click on **My Computer Properties**. Click on **Hardware**, then **Device Manager**. Double click on **Universal Serial Bus Controllers**. Make sure that **USB Mass Storage Device** is listed and there is no yellow question mark or exclamation point. Second, if you are attaching a brand new hard drive, format the drive. Please refer to question 2 for more information. Third, the hard drive that is connected to the TU2-IDSA must be formatted in FAT-16 or FAT-32 in order for Windows 98SE or ME to recognize it

## Q5: Can I connect a SATA drive and an IDE drive simultaneously?

**A5:** Yes. To connect to both IDE hard drive and SATA hard drive with legacy 4-pin power connector, you need a 4-pin Y type power cable to convert a single 4-pin power connector into a double 4-pin power connector.
