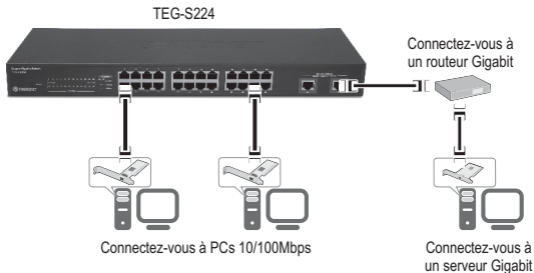
- Un ordinateur avec un adaptateur réseau correctement installé.

- Un environnement exempt de toute source de génération de champ électromagnétique fort (comme les moteurs), de vibration, de poussières et veillez à ce qu'il ne soit pas directement exposé aux rayons du soleil
- Laissez au moins 10 cm d'espace libre à l'avant et à l'arrière du Switch à des fins de ventilation
- Rack standard de 19 pouces ou une surface plane pouvant supporter le poids du Switch

2. Installation du matériel

1. Branchez le cordon électrique au TEG-S224 ainsi qu'à une prise de courant.



2. Branchez un câble réseau RJ-45 entre l'ordinateur et un port Ethernet libre du TEG-S224.



Le commutateur peut être installé dans un rack standard de 19 pouces qui peut être placé dans une armoire de répartition avec les autres équipements.

3. Attachez les supports de montage des deux côtés du switch et fixez-les avec les vis fournies.



4. Installez soigneusement le switch dans le rack. Alignez le support sur les trous des vis du rack et utilisez les vis fournies avec le matériel pour installer le switch.
