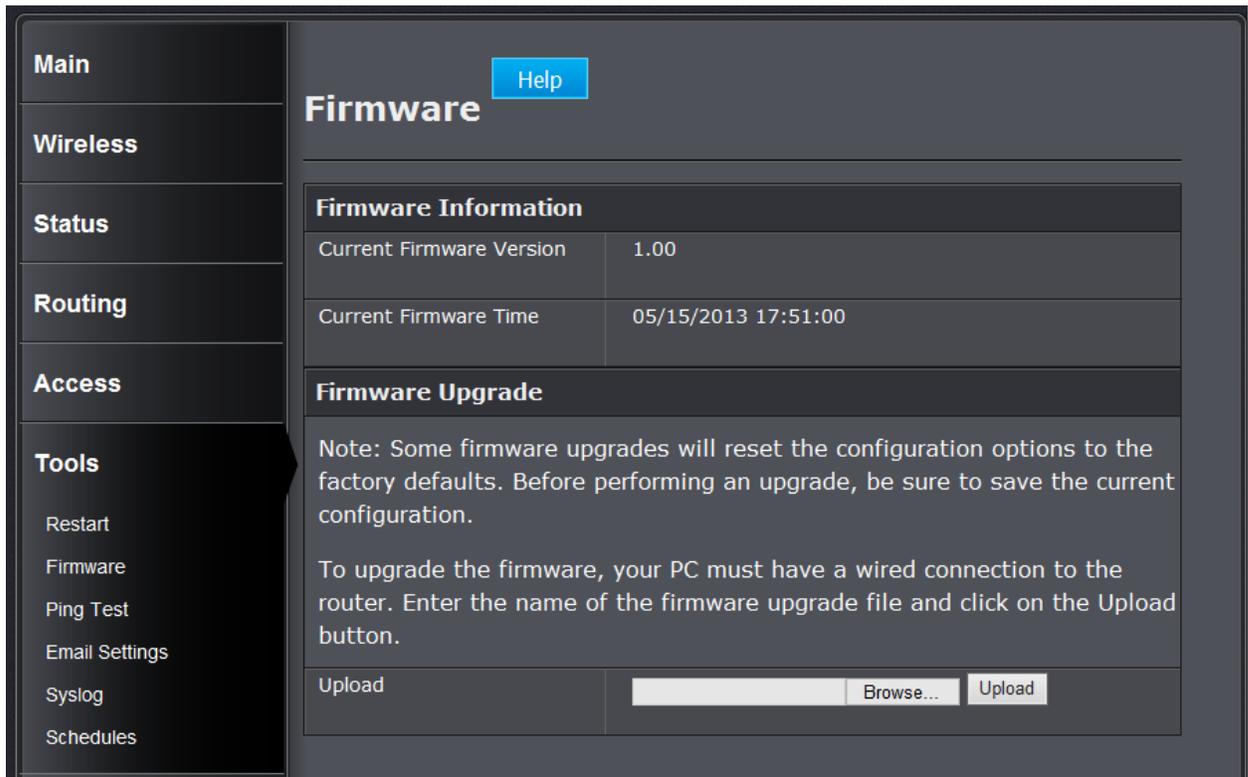


Firmware Upgrade Procedure

1. Save the downloaded firmware file (.zip) to your PC
2. Right click on the downloaded file and select **Extract All** or **Extract Here** option
 - a. Make sure to remember the location where the extracted file will be saved.
3. Log into to the router's configuration page (default URL: <http://tew-751dr> or default IP is 192.168.10.1)
4. Navigate to the **Tools** section and select **Firmware** option.
5. Click **Browse** and select firmware file (.bin) from the extracted files and click the **Upload** button to start the firmware upgrade process.
